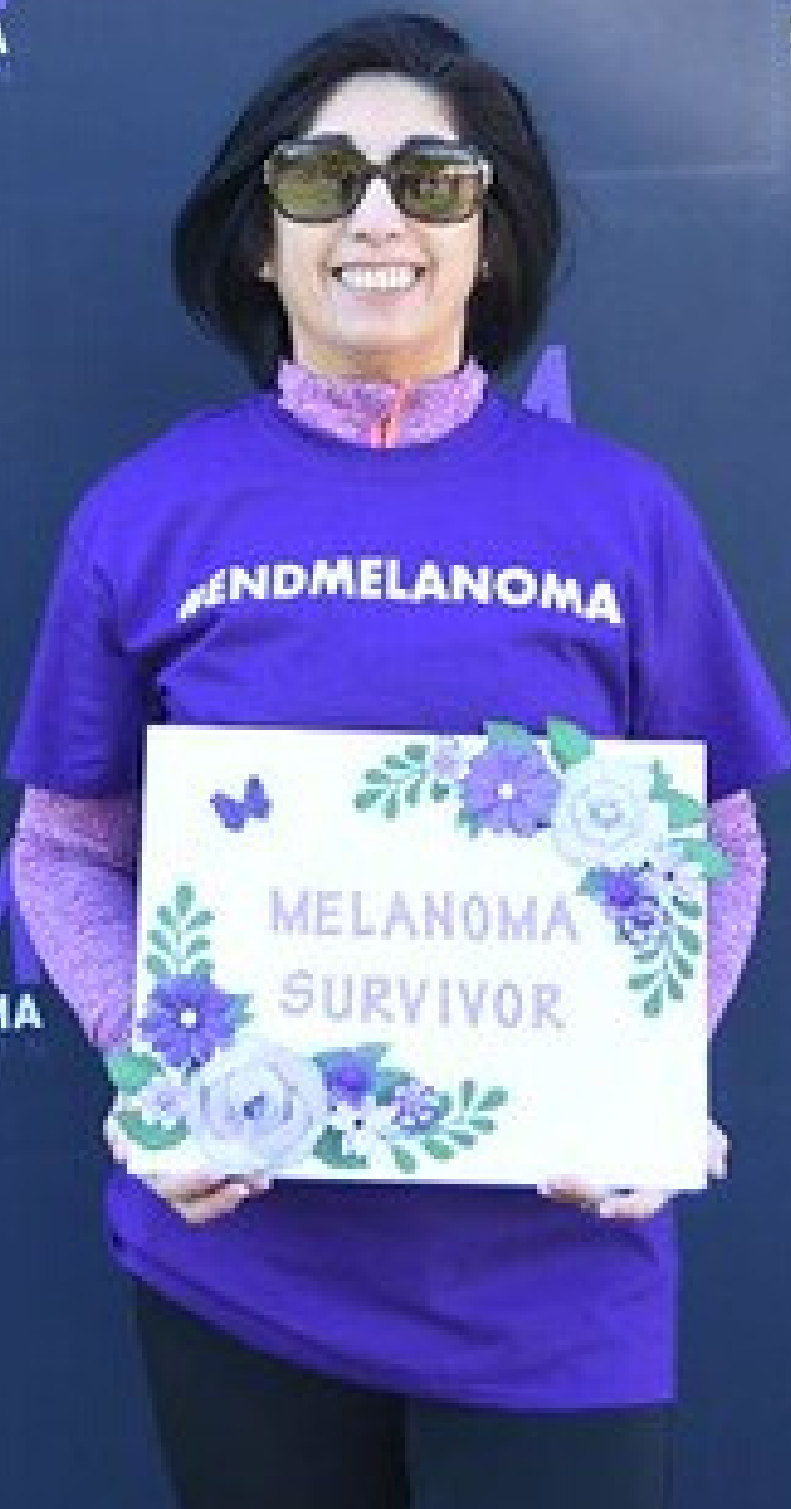

MELANOMA BY THE NUMBERS 2020

264 people are diagnosed with invasive melanoma every day—that's over **11 people** every hour.

7,230 Americans are expected to die of melanoma this year—that's **one person every 72** minutes, and nearly **20 every day**.

The percentage of people who develop melanoma has more than **doubled** in the past 30 years.

Melanoma is the **second** most common cancer in men ages 20-39.

Melanoma is the **third** most common cancer in women ages 20-39.

Melanoma is the **fifth** most common cancer in men and women of all age groups.

By age 65, rates in men **double** those in women, and by age 80 they **triple**.

57,220 cases of invasive melanoma will occur in males.

39,260 cases of invasive melanoma will occur in females.

Approximately 400 new cases of **pediatric melanoma** will be diagnosed.
